

SUPPLY LIST INFANTS 1

Daily Requirements

Brightwheel Message:

Send a message with your child's wake-up time, last bottle, and last diaper change

Monthly Requirements

Feeding Form Submission:

• Required on the 1st of each month for children aged 2-12 months. Inform us of any food changes or allergies as needed.

Diapering Supplies

- · Diapers:
 - Provide enough diapers for a change every 2 hours over a two-week period.
- · Baby Wipes:
 - Send a packet every two weeks or as needed. Teachers will notify you via Brightwheel when a new packet is required.
- · Diaper Cream:
 - Provide your preferred diaper cream. If it's medicated, inform the Administrator.
- · Cloth Diapers:
 - Include an appropriate number of plastic pants or diaper covers as well as liners.

Feeding Supplies

- · Premeasured Bottles:
 - Provide bottles labeled with your child's name, ensuring they are not made of glass for safety. Include enough bottles for the planned feeding period plus one extra feeding.
- · Breast Milk:
 - You can bring frozen breast milk labeled and keep it in the fridge. Inform the teachers.
- Prepared Meals and Snacks (6 months and older):
 - Supply meals and snacks in containers (no glass, as they are warmed in the crockpot) labeled with your child's name.
- Utensils (6 months and older):
 - Include a labeled baby spoon for feeding daily.
- · Sippy Cup of Water (6 months and older):
 - Start sending a sippy cup at 6 months to keep your child hydrated.
- Bibs (6 months and older):
 - Provide 3 cloth bibs and 2 plastic silicone bibs if appropriate for your child.

Weekly Requirements

Two Complete Changes of Clothing:

• Supply clothing sets labeled and stored in a ziplock bag. Additional changes may be needed as required.

Two Crib Sheets:

• Include two crib sheets with your child's name on them. These should fit a crib mattress (mini crib sheet size).

· Sleep Sack:

• If your child uses a sleep sack, state regulations require a doctor's note.

School Year Supplies

Storage Bags:

Provide 1 box of gallon ziplock bags or reusable wet bags.

Baby Sunscreen:

Provide baby sunscreen as needed.

· Baby Insect Repellent:

Provide as needed.

Family Picture:

• Include a family picture (4x6) to help your child feel secure and safe.

Tissue Box:

Supply a tissue box upon request.

These items are essential for your child's comfort and safety. Additional items to help your child feel secure and safe will be kept in their cubby and must comply with licensing requirements.

To ensure a safe and compliant environment for your child, please follow the guidelines outlined below:

Diapering Supplies

Diapers:

• Provide enough diapers to allow for a change every 2 hours (approximately 3-5 daily changes) over a two-week period.

· Baby Wipes:

• Send a weekly packet. Teachers will notify you via Brightwheel when a new packet is needed.

· Cloth Diapers:

 If you use cloth diapers, include an appropriate number of plastic pants or diaper covers, as well as liners.

Diaper Cream:

Provide your preferred diaper cream. If it is medicated, please inform the Administrator.

Feeding Supplies

Prepared Bottles:

- Send pre-made, pre-measured bottles to school. Do not send the water and milk separately. Bottles will be kept in the fridge and warmed as needed in the croc pot.
- All bottles and utensils must be labeled with your child's name. For compliance reasons, we cannot wash bottles or utensils at school; they will be sent home daily.

Meals and Snacks:

• Provide ready-to-feed meals and snacks in labeled, non-glass containers. Food must be cut into 2-inch pieces. Instant food cannot be microwaved at school.

· Breakfast Time:

• Breakfast is served between 8:00 and 8:45 a.m. To avoid disrupting the class, please ensure your child has eaten breakfast at home if they arrive at or after 8:50 a.m.

· Sippy Cups:

• Provide a sippy cup filled with water from home every day. These must be sent home daily and returned the next day. Teachers will refill as needed.

- · Bibs:
 - Include 3 cloth bibs and 2 plastic silicone bibs, labeled with your child's name.

Clothing and Nap Supplies

- · Clothing:
 - Supply three complete changes of clothing, labeled and stored in ziplock bags. Replace clothing as needed. Shoes with sturdy soles are necessary; no open-toed shoes at any time.
- · Nap Supplies:
 - Provide a quilted nap mat with a built-in pillow for your child. Nap mats will be sent home on Fridays for laundering and should be returned on Mondays.
 - Kinder Mat:
 - Provide a kinder mat to make naptime more comfortable for your child. It will be kept in school and disinfected by teachers.

Cleaning and Miscellaneous Supplies

- Cleaning Supplies:
 - Bring 3 tissue boxes and 2 containers of cleaning wipes, replenished as needed.
- Storage Bags:
 - Provide 1 box of gallon ziplock bags or reusable wet bags.
- · Sunscreen:
 - Provide personal sunscreen for your child.
- · Baby Insect Repellent:
 - Provide as needed.
- Additional Items:
 - Comfort objects or loveys are welcome for nap time. Also, please send a 4x6 family picture to help your child feel secure.

TODDLERS

To ensure a safe and compliant environment for your child, please follow the guidelines outlined below:

Feeding Supplies

· Meals and Snacks:

• Provide ready-to-feed meals and snacks in labeled containers. Please mark what is for different meals of the day (breakfast/lunch/snack) or any specification needed.

· Breakfast Time:

• Breakfast is served between 8:00 and 8:45 a.m. To avoid disrupting the class, please ensure your child has eaten breakfast at home if they arrive at or after 8:50 a.m.

· Water Bottle:

• Provide a bottle of water filled with fresh clean water from home every day. These must be sent home daily and returned the next day. Teachers will refill as needed.

Utensils:

• Include a labeled spoon or fork daily. They will be sent home daily, no dishwashing is allowed at school.

Diapering Supplies

Diapers and Wipes:

• Provide enough diapers to allow for a change every 2 hours (approximately 3-5 changes daily) along with wipes.

· Diaper Cream:

Provide your preferred diaper cream.

Clothing and Nap Supplies

Clothing:

- Supply three complete changes of clothing, labeled and stored in ziplock bags.
- Provide an extra pair of shoes.

Nap Supplies
